

Usage of COVID-19 Questionnaire Form

<u>Prospective Users</u>: This form can be completed by Seller/Occupants, Buyers, <u>Inspectors, Contractors and Appraisers</u>.

Necessity to Treat All People the Same: Usage of the form should be uniform with ALL persons, employing the same protocol. You never want anyone to erroneously feel singled out, perhaps based upon any outwardly apparent characteristic (this is a Fair Housing issue). After all, a virus is blind to race, color, creed, age, sexual preference, gender identity, etc.

<u>Safe Storage of Information</u>: It's one thing to ask as a protocol but when you maintain a physical record dealing with anyone's medical data, it gets more complicated. You will need to ensure the completed form is maintained in a locked area just like any client's proprietary, FIRPTA-like information.

<u>Optional Nature of Form</u>: While all persons are provided with the questionnaire, they can elect to decline execution. Of course, the Occupant and/or Buyer may be unwilling to access the Property if there is such a declination.
